Why People Return Back into Bondage

Brethren Unawares—**Galatians 2:4** And that because of false brethren unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage:

Ungodly Men Deny Christ—**Jude 4** For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.

They Hear People & Angels Preach Another Gospel—**Galatians 1:8** But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

They are Deceived—Still a Servant to Sin—**John 8:34** Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin. See also **I John 4:1-5**

They Don’t Read the Holy Scriptures—**Matthew 22:29**...Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures...; **Hosea 4:6** My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge...

They Reject the Power of God—**Matthew 22:29**...Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God. **I Corinthians 1:18** For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God. **II Timothy 3:5** Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

They Stand in the Wisdom of Men—**I Corinthians 2:5** That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God. **Psalm 1:1** Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly

They Follow Women—**Isaiah 3:12** As for my people, children are their oppressors, and women rule over them. O my people, they which lead thee cause thee to err, and destroy the way of thy paths. **Proverbs 31:3** Give not thy strength unto women...

They Choose to Return to Bondage—**Joshua 24:15** And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve **II Timothy 3:4**...lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; **Mark 4:19** And the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful.

Love of Money—**I Timothy 6:10** For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

Roman 6 - 'Living in Sin' or 'Living in Christ?'

There's no such thing as "living in sin" for a Christian; We are living in Christ. "God forbid. How shall we that are dead to sin..." And we are! We're dead! Now, how do we know we're dead? Verse 7: "He that is dead..." Verse 8: "Now if we be dead..." Verse 11: "Reckon ye also yourselves to be dead..." There's no way we can "live in sin." We can live in Christ. We may commit a sin, but we can not live in sin, because a dead man can't live in sin—and we are dead!

Now, the way that thing works is this: As far as the practical outworking of that life goes—this flesh right here—that thing is crucified with Christ. So, right now, our physical body is suffering a slow, lingering death.

In God's sight, we are already dead and buried! God doesn't recognize this flesh. God doesn't pay any attention. As far as God is concerned, we trusted Christ, our flesh is dead and buried and rotting, and that's the end of it.

And the time that we spend now working for this flesh is wasted time—because the Lord doesn't put any of it down. Whatever is done in this flesh, in God's 'computer'. Because our flesh is dead! Romans 4:8 *Blessed is the man to whom the Lord will not impute sin.*

All right, then, inside us, the new man is up walking around. "Nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me. And the life I now live in the flesh..." see? So you have those three things. When you trust Jesus Christ as your Saviour, you go into His life, and His life goes through an open tomb back to a cross. Now, that's a tremendous transaction, brethren.

There is an expression that people use today that is satanic. It is, "Christ coming into my life."

If Christ isn't in your body, you're going to hell. You understand that? "Christ in your life" amounts to nothing at all. If that were true, then He might go in and out of your life every other week. It's Christ in you, the hope of glory. When they substitute that word "life" for "body" they got you off the track.

If we 'give Christ our life,' we'll still go to hell. He's got to be in our body!

We are Dead AND Alive!

There are two men there. There's an outward man, and there's an inward man. II Corinthians 4:14-18 "Knowing that he which raised up the Lord Jesus shall raise up us also by Jesus." There's our resurrection. "For all things are for your sakes, that the abundant grace might through the thanksgiving of many redound to the glory of God. For which cause we faint not..." "...but though our outward man perish..." There's the flesh. "...yet the inward man..." There's the new man. "...is renewed day by day." "While we look not at the things which are seen..." There's the flesh. "...but the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen..." There's the flesh. "...are temporal..." They're timely; they run out with time. "...but the things which are not seen are eternal."

Romans 6:12 "Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof." Now, that's the answer for the Christian. Sin is in us; (Romans 7:17) that's apparent. And we can't get rid of sin until we die; that's apparent. And, although we may not be able to live without sin, we can live above sin. "Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body." Don't let sin sit on the throne and run us. "That ye should obey it in the lusts thereof."

"Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead." There's our third position. "Alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God."
